


Original Model of the Population Type Hollerith Electric Tabulating Machine


FIRST HOLLERITH KEYBOARD PUNCH

Over the keyboard--which was of celluloid--swung a sharp index finger whose movement, after the manner of a pantograph, was repeated in the rear by a punch which perforated the cards.




Sectional View of the Feed Mechanism of the Electric Sorting Machine




The electrical contact brush which determines the distribution of the cards. This brush may be set to sort any vertical column on the cards.

In the Electric Sorting Machine there are twelve control bars (horizontal) and twelve flexible strips (vertical), — one of each for every position on the card.

The brush completes the electric circuit by means of which the cards are controlled.




After passing the contact brush the card is carried along by rollers and dropped into the slot which has been opened to receive it.







One operator and two Electric Sorting Machines can distribute cards into predetermined classifications at the rate of 500 every minute


Sectional view of the feed mechanism showing electrical contact brushes. In the Electric Tabulating Machine there is one of these brushes for each of the forty-five columns on the card.



Every amount represented by a hole in the card is registered on the counter.




Census Card

The bank cancellation appears on the left side of the check and does not interfere in any manner with the punching which is used in conjunction with Electric Tabulating and Accounting Machines.







Interior View of The International Ticketograph




